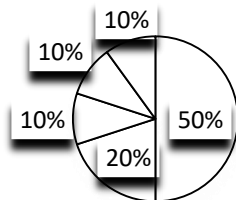

(50% -20% -10% -10% -10%)

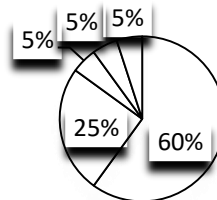
A - 50% B - 20% C - 10% D - 10% E - 10%
