Being Honest with Myself

The Denial Within Me Was Gone

Years before I came to AA, I was aware that there was something dreadfully wrong with me but not one person ever suggested that I might be an alcoholic or that I should try AA. Perhaps that was due to the denial of the people around me that drank like I did. Suggesting that I had a problem with alcohol would mean outing themselves and others. Looking back on it now, I feel fortunate that I survived those last few years of failed attempts at life and when I ran out of options, I came to AA looking for answers. The denial within me was gone. My mind was open and for the first time in my life I was *desperate*, and I was *listening*. At my first AA meeting I was moved by what I heard. It was different than anything I had experienced before. The people were *being honest and candid about things that only brought shame and guilt to me in the past. I felt safe for the first time in my life* and could discuss those things openly, that had been taboo up until then. Prior to that, everything in my life was a façade. At that moment On October 15, 1969, my *perception* of the world had changed, and I have not wanted a drink since. Call it a *Spiritual Awakening* if you like, and it was for me, but it came in the form of a *Profound Change in Perception*. In appendices 2, in the Big Book, (Alcoholics Anonymous) it describes a man who had “*undergone a profound alteration in his reaction to life*”. I began to question all the decisions I had made in the past, and how the residue of those decisions had tarnished and eroded any chance of a successful, happy life.

I became aware that the values system that I had learned as a child, at church and at the Boy Scout meetings etc. was lost in the dust and was replaced with guilt and shame. I was in trouble when I violated my own value system. I now realize that I was not a bad kid, but I was a child that was not strong enough to do the things I knew to be right. The more I broke the rules, the easier it became, and moral standards were meaningless. Soon drinking was the only thing that eased my conscience. When that quit working for me, I found myself at the door of AA. Once I had that change of perception, I knew what to do. It may be as simple as “trying to stop doing the things that I regret” but the key to it all is “Being honest with myself,” and never going back to my old way of thinking. I said that I was fortunate to have survived those last few years of drinking and that I came to AA looking for answers. Being desperate enough to ask for help was the most important part of that experience. I do not believe that anyone could have convinced me to stop drinking against my will. I may have stayed dry long enough to get the heat off, but I doubt that I would have surrendered to the degree necessary to have that change of perception and therefore no spiritual awakening. Getting off in the right direction from the start was especially important to any success I have had in AA. I know that I only live once, and I do not want to waste one moment of the precious life God gave me. Today, as I continue to practice all the things I have learned in the Program, it has resulted in a peace of mind that was unimaginable when I first walked through the doors of AA and, for that, I am extremely grateful.

Intergroup Report – Phone Committee February 2024

The After-Hours Phone Committee is an extension of our Central Office and is responsible for coordinating volunteers to answer telephones (via call forwarding to our mobile or landline telephones) after normal business hours and on holidays. The After-Hours Phone duties are from 5:p.m. to 9:a.m. Monday thru Friday, and Saturday from 1:p.m. thru Monday 9:a.m, and holidays

Committed volunteers are typically each assigned one shift per month, ranging from 3 to 12 hours of Service.

The After-Hours Phone Committee also assists the Central Office in the coordination, accuracy, and distribution of the volunteer 12-Step call list. These 12-Step volunteers are the hands of AA when an alcoholic reaches out for help.

Intergroup Representatives are asked to remind their groups that volunteers are continually needed. Members with a *suggested length of sobriety of 1 year* who wish to be of service may contact the Central Office at 760-758-2514 or text Laura C. at (760) 271-1739, or request information by scanning the QR code below.

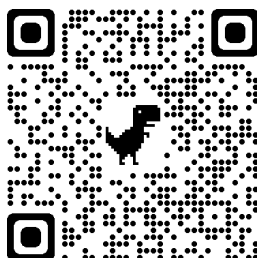
