There were just four of us. Four women, treasuring our sobriety and wanting more than abstinence from alcohol alone. We attended the same AA meetings, listened to each other share, and liked what we heard. But more, we got to know each other and to see the Twelve Steps working in one another's lives.

So we started getting together, just the four of us, gathering for dinner at one another's homes once a month and following dinner with a heartfelt AA meeting.

At first, two of us sponsored the other two. But, even with considerable differences in our years of sobriety, no one wanted to be the group guru. Each felt the need for honest feedback to our daily concerns.

The trust gradually grew deeper, until at last we knew there was nothing we could not safely share in our after-dinner group. What actually developed was that each of us has three loving sponsors.
