The Meeting Guide app—used by people all over the world to find meetings—would no longer show accurate information for our area - Newcomers (and members) would pull into parking lots for meetings that no longer exist, feeling defeated before they even walk through the door. - We would lose the ability to coordinate 12-Step calls, answer emails, or connect with families and friends seeking guidance for a suffering alcoholic - The face of A.A. in our community would fade, and with it, countless opportunities to carry the message would be lost This is what is at stake. Central Office Intergroup is not a convenience, it is vital. But it requires resources. It is the contributions from our groups and members that make it possible to answer every call, update every meeting, and maintain the tools that help the suffering alcoholic find hope. - Have any central offices closed? Yes some central offices do close and some reduce services and continue to be run by volunteers.

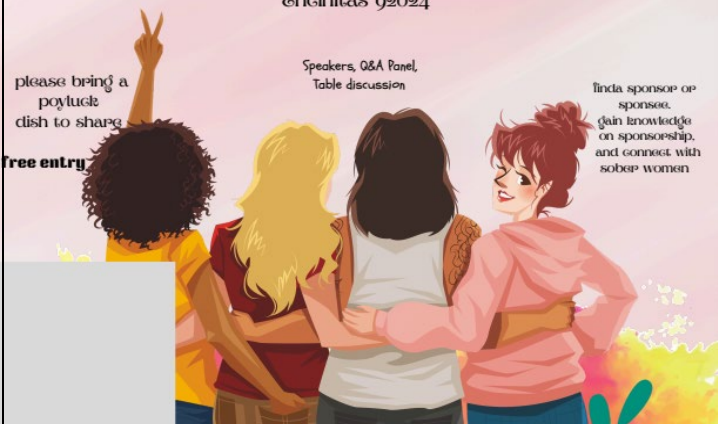
